NEWMARKET CEMETERY – TABLE OF FEES

Effective from 1st April 2011

INTRODUCTION

Fees and Payments

The following rules shall apply in relation to fees and payments.

- (a) The fees and payments within paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 below shall apply where the deceased was an inhabitant (see notes below) or Council Tax payer within Newmarket Town Council area or where either of the parents of a still born child is an inhabitant or Council Tax Payer of the said area.
- (b) The fees and payments within paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 below shall be doubled for all other applications.

Notes

1. For the purpose of this rule, an ‘inhabitant’ shall mean a person who, normally at the date of application or at the date of his or her death, had normally resided some time during the three years immediately prior thereto in the Newmarket Town Council Area.
2. The fees and payments may also be reduced where it can be proved to the Council’s satisfaction that special circumstances exist that would warrant a reduction. The Council’s decision will be final. In cases where a reduction is sought, the full fees should be paid and written application should be made for a refund once the funeral has taken place.
3. Residents who have to move out of the area through no fault of their own to a residential or nursing home are to be treated as though they are still an ‘inhabitant’

1. INTERMENTS **£ p**

For any interment in a grave or vault for which an exclusive right of burial has been granted.

Children

| e) | Where less than 48 hours notice is given of any proposed interment (exclusive of Sundays, Christmas Day or statutory Bank Holiday and with the exception of any immediate interment certified by the coroner or a registered medical practitioner) an additional: | 38.00 |
| f) | Temporary Grave Marker | 27.00 |
| g) | Use of Chapel of Rest | 34.00 |

2. **EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL** (purchase of grave space)

For the exclusive right of burial for a period not exceeding 100 years in a grave space of 9ft by 4ft:

c) **Kerbstone or Borderstone**

(Cost includes laying of foundations for kerbing and borderstones)

d) **A Monument in the form of:**

e) **A Tablet**

Not exceeding 18 inches in height or exceeding 1 sq.ft but not exceeding 4 sq ft in base area
(Does not include foundations for headstone)

f) **Any Inscription after the First**

On any monument, gravestone or tablet

g) **Fees for searches of Registers and for copies
And extracts to be taken therefrom**

| 1. | Every search covering a period of not more than one year | 17.00 |
| 2. | Every search covering a period of more than one year, an additional fees of for every additional year. | 7.00 |
| 3. | Every certified copy of an entry of burial in the register | 22.00 |

h) **Replacement of existing Memorial/Kerbset**

Where an existing monument/kerb set has to be replaced, the fee will be as if it were a new item.
