<p>C/10/05/5 <u>AN INVITATION TO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO PUT QUESTIONS/STATEMENTS OF NOT MORE THAN 3 MINUTES DURATION RELATING TO ITEMS LISTED IN THE PUBLIC PART OF THE AGENDA ONLY</u> Ms Emma Berry asked that the following be added to the list of memorials which needed restoring: Fred Archer (Cemetery), Patrick Connolly (All Saints Churchyard, Albert the Racehorse (Memorial Gardens).</p>	
<p>C/10/05/6 <u>UPDATE ON SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FOR FORDHAM ROAD/CLOCK TOWER ROUNDABOUT AND FRED ARCHER WAY JUNCTIONS</u> The Committee noted that the extension to the island outside Waitrose was almost complete and work on the courtesy crossing in the High Street would commence on 11th May in off-peak hours. SCC would issue a press release when work was complete.</p>

C/10/05/7 BRIEF FROM SHNAG RE KING CHARLES II STATUE FOR THE CLOCK TOWER ROUNDABOUT

The Committee received and noted Ms Hood's letter and Mr J Wadham made the following points:

- SCC had helped to price the project for a statue on the roundabout and, if situated elsewhere, prices would rise and the project would not be viable.
- The House of Lords had given permission for the copy statue under SCC management so siting on the roundabout was vital. Permission would lapse if the site was not accepted.
- There would be no cost to taxpayers as volunteers would pay for such a visible landmark at the entrance to the town. They were unlikely to fund a statue on, say, Rutland Hill.
- The statue would be a tourist attraction, marking Newmarket's history

Councillor Hirst explained that NTC had resolved not to site the statue on the roundabout and this could only be rescinded if six Councillors signed a motion for a further debate.

Three members of the public left the meeting.

C/10/05/8 BRIEF FROM A-BOARD MEETING

Councillor Hirst reported that all traders in Wellington Street, Rous Road, Sun Lane and Old Station Road had been contacted and numbers asking to be included on the new A-Boards were – Wellington Street 5, Rous Road 5, Sun Lane 2, Old Station Road 2. Newmarket Traders to be informed that it would not be possible to have A-Boards for Sun Lane and Old Station Road and FHDC to be asked for help in funding the A-Boards for businesses in Wellington Street and Rous Road.

After further discussion, the following recommendation was agreed:

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C/10/05/10 UPDATE ON REFURBISHMENT OF THE COOPER MEMORIAL

Town Clerk advised that work on the refurbishment would commence immediately.

The Committee noted SCC's quote of £919.68 for moving the advance direction sign on Barbara Stradbroke Avenue and agreed that further quotes should be sought. Councillor Sadler to be asked if he could help meet the cost from his budget.

C/10/05/11 PAINTING OF VENT COLUMNS

Councillor Fletcher advised that Anglian Water had agreed to pay 50% of the costs of refurbishing the vent columns and he had approached the Jockey Club, FHDC, SCC and SHNAG regarding help with funding.

That Town Clerk to obtain quotes for the cost of refurbishing the vent columns in the town. Councillor Fletcher to monitor the project and report back to the Community Services Committee.

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C/10/05/12 REPORT FROM NEWMARKET IN BLOOM

Councillor Hirst advised that £5,000 had been raised for the Hanging Baskets Scheme. Summer bedding would be planted out in the week commencing 17th May and hanging baskets erected week commencing 24th May. The town would be assessed by Anglia in Bloom on 13th July. Volunteers were helping with the Orchard at Studlands Park and the Car Boot Sale.

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Town Clerk advised that the Town Keeper had jet-washed the paving at the War Memorial Gardens and maintained the Cemetery. A new van had been purchased and the NTC logo would be inscribed on it shortly.
