

## Cemetery fees for Newmarket Cemetery 2018-19

Prices are effective from 9 July 2018

### Section 1 - Grave fees (Exclusive Right of Burial (ERB) - Grave Deed)

Item	Charges 2018-19
Lawn type grave (50 years ERB)	£600.00
Child (up to 12 years of age) grave (50 years ERB) Please note: depth for one interment only	£150.00
Cremated Remains Earthen grave (25 year ERB an extension of the ERB to 50 years may be purchased for double the fee)	£450.00

### Section 2 - Interment fees

Item	Charges 2018-19
Person 12 years plus lawn type grave (for depth 1 or 2 )	£650.00
For the digging a grave to triple depth (9ft)	£105.00
Child from the age of 13 months up to the age of 12 years in a child grave only Please note: depth for one interment only	£160.00
Still born babies and babies age 12 months old (including: NVF) Please note: depth for one interment only	£95.00

### Section 3 - Cremated remains Interment fees

Item	Charges 2018-19
Interment of cremated remains in an earthen full burial grave or an earthen cremated remains grave (either loose or in a casket)	£195.00

### Section 4 - Memorial fees

Item	Charges 2018-19
Permit for right to install a new memorial on a grave in the lawned area of the cemetery	£185.00
Permit for right to add an inscription on an existing memorial in any part of the cemetery	£55.00

## Section 5 - Other charges

Use of chapel	£75.00
Surrender of grave space	Buy back at half the ERB fee
Transfer of Exclusive Right of Burial / Production of Statutory Declaration for lost deed	£55.00
Exhumation	POA
Bench at all Town Council owned sites	Gross £1050.00 Net £875.00 Vat £175.00
Additional fee to prepare a grave to accommodate a coffin 6'10" or over in length and 30" or over in width	£65.00

### Double Fees (non-residents fee)

Double fees will apply on all fees to those who reside outside Newmarket Town Council area. To qualify as a resident of the Newmarket Town Council area the deceased must have lived in the town during the last 3 years prior to their death. If a resident has been required to move out of the area for medical care or to a nursing or residential home due no fault of their own, a single fee would apply. Proof of previous residency would be required by the Cemeteries Office with the Notice of Interment. It is the responsibility of the family or Funeral Director to provide this information, failure to do so will result in the payment of double fees.
