DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR THE PARISH OF NEWMARKET IN THE DISTRICT OF FOREST HEATH

SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (PARISH OF NEWMARKET) MODIFICATION ORDER 2018

The above order made on 25 October 2018 if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a public footpath from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) 56474,26295 on Cricket field Road to OSGR 56472,26297 on Granary Road, as shown on the order plan.

Any representation or objection relating to the order must be sent in writing to the Definitive Map Manager, Rights of Way and Access, Suffolk Highways, Phoenix House, 3 Goddard Road, Ipswich IP1 5NP. Objections should be received not later than 10 January 2019, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which they are made. Please bear in mind that such correspondence cannot be treated as confidential and may be inspected by any interested party.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Suffolk County Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the order). If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
