We do not pass on your details to any third party unless you give us permission, or the Council is legally obliged to do so or it is for the prevention or detection of crime or fraud.

What information do we collect?

On accessing the website, the user's IP address is automatically logged by the webserver. Information is collected from you in the form of Questions and feedback received via online forms and written communications.
